Maria has over 40 years of experience in accounting, auditing, and management. She joined her first housing authority, Aleutian Housing Authority, in 1991. Later on, Maria joined Cook Inlet Housing Authority (CIHA) where she served as Chief Financial Officer and Executive Vice President. During her time at CIHA, Maria was instrumental in the transition and implementation of programs and the accounting conversion to governmental GAAP when NAHASDA was implemented in 1997. Maria assumed many different roles on a variety of key projects to further the housing authority's business enterprises and program/project initiatives, such as the creation of a CDFI, and creation of entities to promote the housing authority's growing rental portfolio. Today, Maria continues to be involved in Indian housing programs with the delivery of technical assistance, online and onsite training primarily in governmental accounting, financial management, and auditing. Maria graduated from the University of Alaska, Anchorage with degrees in Business Administration, Accounting (BBA) and Master of Administration (MBA).
