### TRAINING

This 2-day virtual training will provide attendees with an overview of the last steps of the development process - operations and project management of a development project. The training topics will include transition from development to operations, asset management vs property management, organizational structures, day-to-day operations, process and need for policies and procedures, operating budget, and housing counseling.

**Note:** This foundational course will acquaint Tribal and TDHE staff with the basic requirements of Development Planning and opportunities that are available. This is the third session of a 3-part series on Development Planning.
